PRAYING ON THE ARMOR OF GOD

"Father, I pray on the belt of truth (Eph. 6:14), and I ask that you surround me with your truth. I declare that Jesus is the truth (Jn. 1:14, 14:6). I thank you that I can know the truth and that the truth can set me free (Jn. 8:32). I thank you that the Spirit of God can guide me into all truth (Jn. 16:13). I ask that this day you would give me the gift of discernment (1 Cor. 12:10) in order to know, understand and act on the truth. I also ask that you would help to speak the truth in love to everyone I meet (Eph. 4:15)."

"Father, I pray on the breastplate of righteousness (Eph. 6:14). I thank you that I have the righteousness of God through Christ (2 Cor. 5:21, Phil. 3:8,9). I pray that today I will be dead to sin and alive to righteousness (Rom. 6:17,18). I thank you that my breastplate of righteousness covers all my vital organs and protects them from evil. I pray that I will offer myself as a slave to righteousness, and pass on a heritage of righteousness to my children and their children (Ps. 103:17,18)."

"Father, I pray on the shoes of the gospel of peace (Eph. 6:15). I declare that Jesus is the prince of peace (Is. 9:6). I thank you that Jesus is my peace and that He broke down the wall of hostility between God and man so that I now have peace with God (Eph. 2:14-18, Rom. 5:1,2). I ask for the peace of God that transcends all understanding guarding my heart and mind in Christ Jesus (Phil. 4:6,7). I ask that I would live at peace with everyone and that you will help me to bring peace to every situation and person I encounter today (Rom. 12:18, 14:19)."

"Father, I take up the shield of faith (Eph. 6:16). I thank you that my faith is a gift from God through my Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 2:8,9). I thank you for your Word, which can help to increase my faith (Rom. 10:17). I know that without faith it is impossible to please you so I ask that you would help me to become a man of greater faith (Heb. 11:1,6) and to walk by faith and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7). I thank you that the shield of faith is able to protect me from all of the flaming arrows of the evil one (Eph. 6:16) and I pray a hedge of protection around me and my family today, keeping us from the evil one (Job 1:10)."

"Father, I take up the sword of the spirit, God's Word (Eph. 6: 17). I thank you that your Word is living, active, powerful and eternal (Heb. 4:12, Is. 40:8, Matt. 24:35, 1 Pet. 1:25). I thank you that your Word is God-breathed and profitable to equip me for every good work (2 Tim. 3:16,17). I pray that I will hide your Word in my heart and become one who correctly handles the Word of truth (Ps. 119:9-11, 2 Tim. 2:15). I ask that the Spirit of God would give me the Word I need in order to experience victory today (Matt. 4:1-11, Jn. 14:26)."

"Father, I put on the helmet of salvation (Eph. 6:17). I thank you that my salvation is gift from God through my Lord Jesus Christ (Eph. 2:8,9). I thank you that the helmet of salvation protects my mind (Rom. 12:1,2, Col. 3:1-3). I pray today for the mind of Christ (1 Cor. 2:16). I pray that I will be transformed by the renewing of my mind (Rom. 12:1,2) and I pray that I will take every thought captive to Jesus Christ (2 Cor. 10:4,5). I pray that I will only think on what is true, noble, right, pure, lovely, admirable, excellent and praiseworthy (Phil. 4:8). I thank you that my salvation is secure. I thank you that nothing can separate me from the love of Christ (Rom. 8:35-39) that no one can take me out of my Father's hand (Jn. 10:27-30), and that my new life is hidden with Christ in God (Col. 3:1-3). I ask that you will help me to live a life worthy of my calling and continue to work out my salvation with fear and trembling (Eph. 4:1, Phil. 2:12,13). And I ask that as I have opportunity, I will share the glorious gospel of God (Rom. 10:14,15)."
